

Expose Containers in LXD to the Host Network Using Bridging

You can have LXD containers connect directly to the same network as your host. In order to do this, you must [setup a bridge on your OS](#).

Then execute the LXD profile editor,

```
lxc profile edit default.
```

After which, change `lxdbr0` to your bridge,

```
config: {}
description: Default LXD profile
devices:
  eth0:
    name: eth0
    nictype: bridged
    parent: lxdbr0
    type: nic
name: default
```

In this case, our bridge is `br0`

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description: Default LXD profile
devices:
  eth0:
    name: eth0
    nictype: bridged
    parent: br0
    type: nic
name: default
```

Verify changes,

```
lxc profile show default
```

Now your new LXD containers should be visible within the same network used by the host.
