

Resolve Proxy Caching Problem with Ubuntu Updates

just curious to know if there is a negative repercussion in doing the following steps even if we weren't behind a firewall?

If you are behind a proxy you may run into a [problem with how the proxy is caching](#) things. You may receive the error message,

```
W: GPG error: http://ca.archive.ubuntu.com intrepid-updates Release: The
following signatures were invalid: BADSIG 40976EAF437D05B5 Ubuntu Archive
Automatic Signing Key <ftpmaster@ubuntu.com>
W: You may want to run apt-get update to correct these problems
```

To fix that do the following,

```
sudo apt-get update -o Acquire::http::No-Cache=True
sudo apt-get update
```

If that does not solve it try,

```
sudo apt-get update -o Acquire::BrokenProxy=true
sudo apt-get update
```
